Application Deadline: November 2, 2009

Programs are open to all undergraduate and graduate students from all CUNY campuses (unless restricted by level of study, language fluency, or other program criteria).

Additional costs: Budget for meals and personal expenses: approx. \$15–20 per day.

Financial Aid: STOCS Travel Grants

Participants in winter programs are eligible for STOCS (Study/Travel Opportunities for CUNY Students) travel grants. STOCS scholarships, ranging from \$500 to \$1,500 are offered to undergraduate CUNY students who participate in short-term (summer and winter intersessions) CUNY study abroad programs.
