THE REGISTRATION PROCESS

CLASSES BEGIN ON MONDAY, JANUARY 4

Registration will be on eSIMS via the CUNY portal at <http://www.cuny.edu> or in your department.

Registering Online: <https://www.cuny.edu>

To register online, you must have your CUNY Portal user name and your password. Simply log on to the CUNY Portal and under *SSO Applications for Students* click on eSIMS. On the eSIMS menu, select the option *Registration*. Upon completion of your transaction, you should view your schedule to ensure that you have successfully registered for the appropriate courses.

eSIMS is available via the CUNY portal 7 days a week from 6:00 am until 2:59 am, EXCEPT on December 24, 25, 30, and 31, and January 1.

Registering via a Department (department locations are listed on the inside back cover):

Departments have the option of registering students into their courses. It is particularly helpful to register through a department when:

- you have met the prerequisites for a course and the information is not yet noted on your record.
- a course is closed and you want to request an over-tally.
- there are restrictions on a course that you feel you have already met.
